<b>Due date of application:</b>	The 1 <sup>st</sup> Semester entry: 10 <sup>th</sup> June The 2 <sup>nd</sup> Semester entry: 10 <sup>th</sup> October Summer Semester entry: 10 <sup>th</sup> April
<b>Exams:</b>	The 1 <sup>st</sup> Semester: Mid-term - 5 <sup>th</sup> week of September to 2 <sup>nd</sup> week of October / Final - 1 <sup>st</sup> week of December to 2 <sup>nd</sup> week of December The 2 <sup>nd</sup> Semester: Mid-term - 2 <sup>nd</sup> week of March to 3 <sup>rd</sup> week of March / Final - 3 <sup>rd</sup> week of May to 4 <sup>th</sup> week of May
