In addition to meeting all the academic and financial requirements pursuant to the Sacramento State admission requirements in existence at the time of a student's application for admission to Sacramento State:

Students who fulfill the existing Sacramento State English admission requirement; i.e., TOEFL score of 61 or IELTS score of 6.0, may apply for direct admission to Sacramento State. Students who apply through the Program and have completed English language preparation in The Republic of China offered by NCUE may transfer to IEP.
