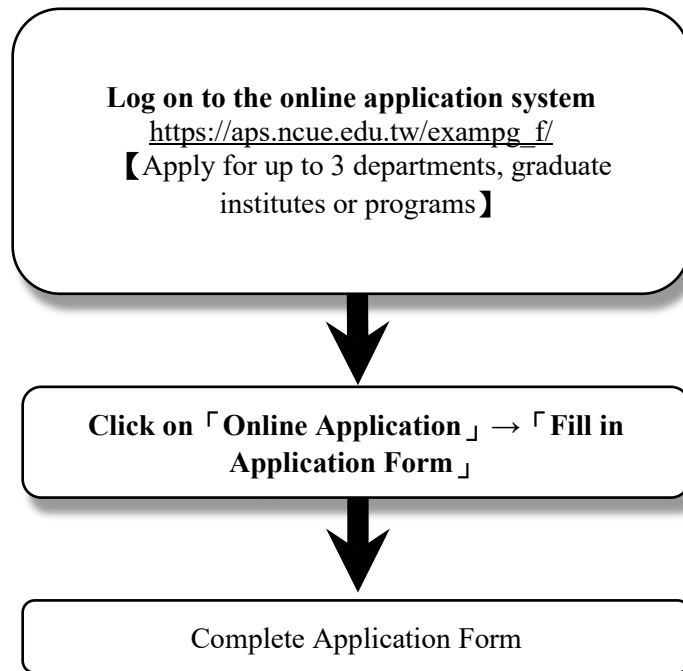

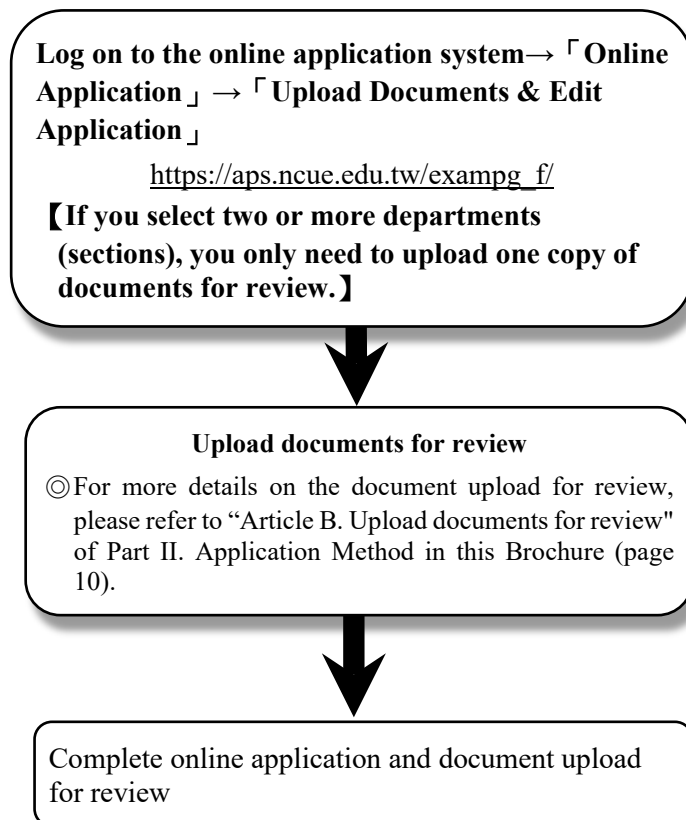

## Application Instructions

### I. Eligibility

- A. A person of foreign nationality who has never held Republic of China (“ROC”) nationality and who does not have overseas Chinese student status at the time of his/her application.
- B. A person of foreign nationality who meets the following requirements and who in the immediate past has resided overseas continuously for at least six years (up to August 1, 2023):
  - 1. A person who at the time of his/her application also holds dual R.O.C. nationality shall have never had household registration in Taiwan.
  - 2. A person who before the time of his/her application also held dual R.O.C. nationality but no longer does at the time of his/her application shall have renounced his/her R.O.C. nationality with the approval of the Ministry of the Interior on a date at least eight full years (up to August 1, 2023) before making his/her application.
  - 3. The persons referred to in the preceding two subparagraphs must have never previously undertaken studies in Taiwan as an overseas Chinese student nor have accepted a placement by the University Entrance Committee for Overseas Chinese Students in the current academic year.

A foreign national who was selected by a foreign government, organization, or school to study in Taiwan in accordance with the Education Cooperation Framework Agreement, and who has never had household registration in Taiwan may be given exemption from the restrictions set out in the preceding two paragraphs if the competent education administrative authority gives approval.

A person who held both foreign and R.O.C. nationalities and applied for annulment of his/her R.O.C. nationality before the date of effect of the February 1, 2011 amendment to the Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan may apply for admission as an international student in accordance with the provisions in place before the amendment and is not subject to the restrictions set out in Paragraph B.

✖The aforementioned ROC nationality is defined in accordance with Article 2 of the Nationality Act:

A person shall have the national of the ROC under any of the conditions provided by the following Subparagraphs:

- i. His/her father or mother was a national of the ROC when he/she was born.
- ii. He/she was born after the death of his/her father or mother, and his/her father or mother was a national of the ROC at the time of death.
- iii. He/she was born in the territory of the ROC, and his/her parents can't be ascertained or both were stateless persons.
- iv. He/she has undergone the naturalization process.

Preceding Subparagraph i and Subparagraph ii shall also apply to the persons who were minors at the time of the amendment and promulgation of this Act.

C. An applicant of foreign nationality, who is eligible for permanent residence in Hong Kong or Macao, who has never had household registration in Taiwan, and who at the time of his/her application has resided in Hong Kong, Macao, or elsewhere overseas continuously for at least six years (up to August 1, 2024).

D. An applicant who was formerly from the Mainland Area has foreign nationality and has never had household registration in Taiwan, and who at the time of his/her application has resided overseas continuously for at least six years (up to August 1, 2024).

The term “overseas” used in Paragraph B, C, D refers to countries or regions other than the Mainland Area, Hong Kong, and Macau; the term “reside overseas continuously” means that an international student has stayed in Taiwan for no more than a total of 120 days in each calendar year. When calculating the number of consecutive years spent overseas, if the initial or final year of the period is not a complete calendar year, any time spent in Taiwan in the initial or final year must not exceed 120 days.

The only exceptions to this method of calculation are for those who fulfill one of the following requirements with supporting documents. It is not counted when calculating how long they were in Taiwan in a particular year if the person has documentary proof that they:

1. Attended an overseas youth training course organized by the Overseas Compatriot Affairs Council or a technical professional training program accredited by the Ministry of Education;
2. Spent a total period of less than two years undertaking Chinese language classes at a Chinese language center at a university or tertiary college which has Ministry of Education approval to recruit students overseas;
3. Spent a total period of less than two years in Taiwan as an exchange student; or
4. Spent a total period of less than two years undertaking an internship that they came to Taiwan to undertake with the approval of the designated central competent authority.

E. International students must have graduated from the high schools, colleges or universities recognized by the Ministry of Education (for more information, please visit:



<http://depart.moe.edu.tw/ED2500/>). International students with a foreign high school diploma may apply for the undergraduate programs at National Changhua University of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the University"); those with a bachelor's degree or an equivalent academic qualification may apply for the University's Master's programs; those with a Master's degree or an equivalent academic qualification may apply for the University's doctoral programs.

※Graduates from the schools in Hong Kong or Macau where the graduation grade is equivalent to the second grade of Taiwan's high schools may apply for the University's undergraduate programs, but need to take 16 additional credits within the study period in accordance with the University's requirement to complete their study. The said students may apply for an additional year of study.

## II. Application Method

### A. Online application (Applications received after the deadline will not be processed):

**Fall Semester: 1st Round – from 9 a.m. on February 01, 2024 to 5 p.m. on March 29, 2024 (Taiwan time; GMT+8); 2nd Round – from 9 a.m. on April 01, 2024 to 5 p.m. on May 31, 2024 (Taiwan time; GMT+8)**

**Spring Semester: From 9 a.m. on September 02, 2024 to 5 p.m. on October 31, 2024 (Taiwan time; GMT+8).**

2. Fill out the form completely and accurately: Please refer to page 4 of the Brochure for the application procedure.
- 3. Apply for up to 3 departments, graduate institutes or programs.**
4. Notes for online application:
  - a. It is suggested to use Google Chrome or Firefox 10.x version (and above) for online application. Please do not use tablet computers, mobile phones, to avoid the loss of application data.
  - b. To avoid network congestion, please log onto the website and complete online application as soon as possible. Late applications are not accepted; please pay attention to the deadline so as to avoid failing to fill out the application form, due to the shutdown of the application system.
  - c. Applicants who upload the application materials online and are qualified for admissions, will be deemed to agree to provide relevant information to admission personnel for the purpose of review, announcement of admissions, data transfer to the University's student academic record system after admission, and agree that the University provides relevant information for the local alumni association for the purpose of contact for application, admission notice, scholarships, etc.; If you do not agree with the foregoing matters, please inform us prior to release of admission decisions.

**B. Upload documents for review:** Please merge the following documents into one PDF file and upload it to the application system by clicking on “Online Application” →” Upload Documents & Edit Application” **within the prescribed time limit. Documents uploaded after the deadline will not be processed.**

1. **Application form for admission:** After applying online, go to “Search for Information” → “Download Application Form”, print out the form, attach a 2-inch half-length and bareheaded photo taken within the last three months at the top of the form, sign your name at the bottom of the form, scan the form and upload it to the online application system with the other documents.
2. **Identification document:** A photocopy of the passport or other documents for proof of nationality. A photocopy of the Alien Resident Certificate is required if available.  
✖If the applicant meets the provisions in Article 2 of the Ministry of Education’s Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan, has a foreign nationality as required and possesses (or possessed) a ROC nationality, then the applicant needs to provide immigration records for the past six years, certificate of ROC nationality renouncement or other supporting documents.
3. **Declaration Form (see Appendix I)**
4. **Checklist and Affidavit for International Students Seeking to Study in Taiwan (See Appendix II)**
5. **Academic credentials:** The official highest academic credential from a foreign school or equivalent documents proving the academic qualifications and yearly transcripts authenticated by a Taiwan Overseas Representative Office or an institute established or appointed by or a private agency commissioned by the Executive Yuan (If the documents are in languages other than Chinese or English, an authenticated Chinese or English translation should be additionally attached.)
  - a. Academic credentials from Mainland China: The provisions in Method for Recognition of Mainland China Academic Credentials shall apply.
  - b. Academic credentials from Hong Kong or Macau: The provisions in Method for Verification and Recognition of Hong Kong and Macau Academic Credentials shall apply.
  - c. Academic credentials from other areas:
    - (a) The academic credential from an overseas Taiwanese school or a school in Mainland China for Taiwanese merchants shall be regarded as the same as that from a domestic school of an equivalent level.
    - (b) Foreign academic credentials from schools other than the two areas referred to in the preceding paragraphs shall be processed in accordance with the provisions in Method for Recognition of Foreign Academic Credentials by Universities. However, if the academic credential is issued by a foreign school established or with a branch established in Mainland China, the academic credential shall be notarized by a notary public in Mainland China and authenticated by an institute established or appointed by or a civil group commissioned by the Executive Yuan.

- ※If the authentication process cannot be completed before the application deadline, a signed Affidavit for Presentation of Admission Documents (see Appendix IV) must be submitted. If admitted, the student must provide at registration **the original copy of diploma and transcript authenticated by a Taiwan Overseas Representative Office or an institute established or appointed by or a private agency commissioned by the Executive Yuan.** The admission will be cancelled if such documents cannot be submitted on time.
- ※The transcript must include grades for courses in every semester.
- ※If the applicant is a recent graduate, the diploma does not need to be submitted for the application, but must be submitted at the time of registration, otherwise the admission will be cancelled.
- ※For information about the websites of the Overseas Representative Offices, please refer to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs website (<http://www.taiwanembassy.org>).

**6. Autobiography (Study plan should be included for the applicants for doctoral or Master's programs.)**

It can be written in Chinese or English without specific requirements for contents or formats. If you apply for several department programs (sections), it is suggested that the content is applicable to multiple department programs (sections). Please edit it with word processing software (such as WORD) and then convert it to PDF format.

**7. A proof of financial resources of at least NTD\$77,500 (US\$2,500) or a proof of scholarship (please choose one of the following).**

- a. A photocopy of proof of financial resources issued by a financial institution within the past three months which demonstrates financial sustainability for the student's study in Taiwan.

※If the certificate of deposit is not under the applicant's name, **the proof of sponsor's financial resources (see Appendix III) and certificate of deposit are required.**

- b. Proof of full scholarship offered by a government agency, NCUE or a civil organization.

**8. Other documents required by the department or program:**

- a. Applicants must take the Test of Proficiency-Huayu SC-TOP organized by the Steering Committee for the Test of Proficiency-Huayu SC-TOP (<http://www.sc-top.org.tw/>) in accordance with regulations of departments. Please see the List of Departments/Graduate Institutes Accepting Enrollment in this brochure (page 16 to 20).
- b. Those who wish to apply for the International Master Program in Engineering and International Program for Master of Science in Materials and Biological Technology, and Science Education are required to have basic English listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills, and provide evidence of English proficiency. Applicants from the list of nations (please refer to: <https://reurl.cc/q0ZVpD>) with English as the official or common language do not need to provide evidence of English proficiency.



- c. If an international student accepts a Chinese conditional admission offer, he or she will

have to first study a Chinese language program at the Language Center at NCUE and obtain a Chinese proficiency certificate at the designated level or above in order to be accepted for enrollment. The Chinese conditional admission offer will remain valid for at most 1 year, and will be cancelled if he or she fails to provide such documents within the 1-year time frame.

- d. If an international student accepts an English conditional admission offer, he or she will have to submit an English proficiency certificate at the designated level or above in order to be accepted for enrollment. The English conditional admission offer will remain valid for at most 1 year, and will be cancelled if he or she fails to provide such documents within the 1-year time frame.
- e. Those who wish to apply to the Department of Fine Arts, please provide a portfolio of works (at least 6 works in PDF format. The total file size does not exceed 200MB. If the file of video works is too large, please provide the web link to your cloud storage).

**9. For an application for admission to a doctoral program, the applicant needs to submit a Master's thesis. If the thesis is written in a foreign language, a summary in Chinese or English is required (this requirement is waived if the applicant needs not write a Master's thesis, but relevant proof documents must be provided).**

#### **C. Notes for uploading electronic documents online:**

- 1. It is suggested to use Google Chrome or Firefox 10.x version (and above) to apply for admission online.
- 2. **The above listed documents shall be made into PDF files and then merged into a single PDF file. It is recommended to use pure texts or static graphics in the PDF instead of videos or other special features (e.g., attachments, links or Flash), to avoid failure of presenting complete uploaded contents.**
- 3. Applicants shall upload the required documents before the deadline for application and document upload. The file upload will no longer function after the deadline.
- 4. Applicants can review and update any of the information provided at any time within the period for document upload. After the deadline for application, the University will no longer accept any other documents and applicants can no longer change any of the information provided. **Any incomplete application will be deemed as unqualified and the applicant shall be held fully liable for it.**
- 5. **A student who submits forged, fabricated or altered documents shall be subject to admission cancellation; or a revocation of enrollment and denial to the request of any certificate pertaining to study, if the said student has already been enrolled; or revocation of graduation qualifications and confiscation or cancellation of the diploma, if the said student has been already graduated.**

## IV. Notes for Application

- A. An applicant may apply for admission to not more than 3 departments, graduate institutes or programs, but may enroll in only one department or graduate institute (section) at the time of registration.
- B. Applicants are required to have Chinese or English skills in listening, speaking, reading and writing. Applicants are also required to have passed all the courses taken in the school previously attended. Applicants for undergraduate admission must have earned an average grade and a grade in each of core courses related to the intended field of study at NCUE of at least C or 60. Applicants for graduate admission must have earned an average grade and a grade in each of core courses related to the intended field of study at NCUE of at least B or 70.
- C. The number of admitted students for the International Foundation Program is 40. Admission applications are reviewed by the review committee. Those who pass the review will be submitted to the NCUE President for approval, and admission notices will be issued accordingly. In the first year, students must take preparatory Chinese language classes at the International Foundation Program, during which they are not allowed to transfer to other schools or departments. They are required to take at least 15 hours of classes per week, totaling a minimum of 720 hours within one year, and must achieve a basic level A2 in the TOCFL (Test of Chinese as a Foreign Language) listening and reading tests before completing the preparatory classes. From the second year onwards, they must achieve a basic level B1 in the TOCFL listening and reading tests by the end of their first year as undergraduate students at NCUE, and are eligible to apply for transfer to the departments related to manufacturing, construction, agriculture, and long-term care services at NCUE or other schools. A total of 125 credits (excluding compulsory credits for military training, nursing, physical education, and educational programs) are required for graduation. Graduation credits must include at least 28 compulsory credits, 38 departmental compulsory credits, and 62 elective credits. Of the elective credits, up to 39 credits from other departments can be counted, with a maximum of 9 credits outside of courses offered by the College of Engineering, College of Management, College of Science, and College of Technology.
- D. Some courses in various departments are divided into two parts, and are offered over both the Fall and Spring semesters. However, due to the prerequisite requirement, students must complete the first part in the Fall semester before they can enroll in the second part in the Spring semester. Therefore, the course planning of students admitted to the Spring semester may be affected, and they may need to adjust their course plans or prepare for a delayed graduation schedule.
- E. Department reviewers may request to interview applicants during the document reviewing period.
- F. According to the requirement of the Ministry of Education, international students who are expelled from a university or college due to behavioral issues, poor academic performance or a conviction under the criminal code may not apply for admission under the “Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan”. Any violation of this requirement that is verified will result in an immediate cancellation of the individual’s admission.
- G. An international student submitting forged, fabricated, or altered documents for the purpose of

NCUE application shall be subject to enrollment qualification cancellation; or a revocation of enrollment and denial to the request of any certificate pertaining to study, if the said student is already enrolled; or revocation of graduation qualifications and cancellation of the diploma by the University, if the student has been graduated.

- H. By submitting an application, applicants agree to grant National Changhua University of Education the right to use the basic information and relevant files obtained through these admission procedures for the purpose of admission, registration, statistical research and educational administration. The relevant regulations stipulated in the “Personal Information Protection Act” shall apply to other matters.

NOTE: Before the completion of the first year of study in International Foundation Program, students who have not reached the Level 2 (A2) for the Test of Chinese as a Foreign Language (TOCFL)'s Listening and Reading Comprehension, or who have not reached the Level 3 (B1) for the TOCFL's Listening and Reading Comprehension since the second year of study at the department will be suspended from school and arrangements of departure from Taiwan will be made.

## **VIII. Registration and Enrollment**

- A. Please follow the instructions and schedule indicated in the admission notice to complete the enrollment process.
- B. Admitted students should submit at the time of registration the original copy of the official highest academic credential from a foreign school and yearly grade reports authenticated by a Taiwan Overseas Representative Office, an institute established or appointed by or a private agency commissioned by the Executive Yuan. (All original documents will be returned after



inspection.)

C. Anyone who applies for a resident visa in Taiwan must submit an official certification of measles and German measles vaccination.

## **XI. Miscellaneous**

A. International students' admission is based on the school's "Study Regulations" and "Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan".

B. The School's Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan was established in accordance with "Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan" promulgated by the Ministry of Education (MOE). If the MOE regulations are revised, the latest MOE regulations shall prevail.

C. Those who are admitted to the school and become bachelor, Master's or doctoral international students (exchange students and non-degree students excluded) are entitled to the Enrollment Incentive for International Student (<http://oica.ncue.edu.tw/regulation/others?locale=en>). For application for scholarships and financial assistance, please refer to the Office of International and Cross-strait Affairs. Students of International Foundation Program will be granted the scholarship from the semester of studying at the department.



D. Admission to the University does not guarantee visa issuance; the visa has to be issued by the Bureau of Consular Affairs of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, or a Taiwan Overseas Representative Office.

E. All overseas Chinese students and international students of the school are guaranteed a place in student dormitories.

F. For the safety of students, regular/irregular visits will be conducted by the advisors from the Office of International and Cross-strait Affairs or faculty members from the departments to the students who live off campus.

G. After enrolling at the University, students should observe all the regulations stipulated by the faculty and the student representatives.

H. The foreign graduate student must take at least one course per semester, and pay the related fees according to regulations.

I. There are two campuses at NCUE: the Jin-de Campus and the Bao-shan Campus. School addresses are as follows:

Jin-de Campus: 1, Jin-de Road, Changhua City 500207, Taiwan, R.O.C.

Bao-shan Campus: 2, Shi-da Road, Changhua City 500208, Taiwan, R.O.C.

J. Any matters not covered in this admission brochure shall be in accordance with the relevant laws and regulations and the resolution of the University Review Committee.

According to the "Regulations Regarding Study and Counseling Assistance for Overseas Chinese Students in Taiwan," the term "overseas Chinese student" refers to a student of Chinese descent who has come to Taiwan to study, who was born and lived overseas until the present time, or who has been living overseas for six or more consecutive years in the immediate past and obtained permanent or long-term residency status overseas. However, a minimum of eight consecutive years of overseas residency is required if the person is applying to study in a university department of medicine, dentistry, or Chinese medicine in Taiwan.

The term "overseas" refers to countries or regions other than Mainland China, Hong Kong and Macau. The consecutive years of overseas residency means calendar years in each of which an overseas Chinese student has not spent more than 120 days in Taiwan. When calculating the number of consecutive years spent overseas, if the initial or final year of the period is not a complete calendar year, any time spent in Taiwan in the initial or final year must not exceed 120 days.
