Medical insurance plan information:	<p>For matriculation at TUC each student needs to show proof of sufficient health insurance. Students who have a European Health Insurance Card do not have to take out health insurance in Germany.</p> <p>Germany and Turkey have an agreement regarding health insurance. If students from Turkey have a particular health insurance, they do not have to take out health insurance in Germany.</p> <p>German statutory health insurance companies no longer accept health insurance from some non-European countries, i.e. it is recommended that students take out health insurance in Germany. Students can choose between private and statutory health insurance companies. Statutory companies charge approx. 80-90 Euro per month.</p>
Recommended date of arrival:	<p>A 3-week German language course for non-degree students is offered before the semester starts, i.e. if students would like to participate in the German course arrival prior to the start of the German courses is recommended (beginning of September for winter term, beginning of March for summer term).</p> <p>If students do not wish to participate in the German course arrival prior to the orientation week, which takes place at the very beginning of each semester (April, October), is recommended.
