

**Notes for the Departure and Entry of Foreign Students
Attending National Changhua University of Education**

Prior to the departure or entry of a foreign student, the student first needs to have a valid passport and original copy of his/her residence permit.

The documents to be carried upon departure and entry are described below:

Departure

*** Original passport valid for at least six months from the departure date.**

*** Valid original residence permit**

With the above documents, the student may directly leave for airport and carry out issue exit formalities there.

Entry

*** Original passport valid for at least six months and the valid residence permit**

*** Be sure to properly fill in the yellow ED Card on the plane and hand it over to Taiwan Customs upon entering.**

Comments: If the residence permit is expired, an extension first must be issued by the responsible unit (always remember to carry your passport and student ID card); for more information, refer to *Residence Permit Issue*.
