

**Directions for Exemption of Tuition and Miscellaneous Fees of Overseas Chinese Students at
National Changhua University of Education**

Approved by Administrative Conference on April 7, 2004

Approved by Administrative Conference on October 1, 2008

I. These important points have been established to support overseas Chinese students that have traveled long distances to study here.

II. This exemption of tuition and miscellaneous fees shall apply to poor overseas Chinese students enrolled in this university that meet at least one of the following cases and file an application.

(I) Overseas students that have been recommended or are qualified by passing the examination (with records).

(II) Overseas students who are qualified by passing the entrance examination in the Hong Kong and Macao regions (with records).

(III) Overseas students who come to Taiwan alone and pass the examination of education organizations as requested through a letter written by the Overseas Community Affairs Council (with records).

(IV) Overseas students who are recommended by sister schools of this school and are enrolled through screening.

All of the above students (except those registered and recorded in the Ministry of Education) shall attach a local document of low-income proof in Chinese.

III. Enrolled overseas Chinese students with any of the following conditions shall not file an application:

(I) Already benefitting from public assistance.

(II) Punished with the recording of a small demerit at least once.

(III) Involved in a criminal case and sentenced by the court but failed to be punished with commutation to fines or declared probation.

IV. Enrolled overseas Chinese students that were unable to apply in a previous term due to (II) or (III) set forth in the previous paragraph, once they properly correct their mistakes, may apply for exemption of tuition and miscellaneous fees in the following term once reviewed and approved by the Student Affairs Conference of this school.

V. Regarding the time that applications for the exemption of tuition and miscellaneous fees are accepted, freshmen shall file an application to the Student Affairs Division within the first month after the start of the first semester. Meanwhile, sophomores and above shall handle application pursuant to announcements made by the Student Affairs Division at the end of the

previous term.

VI. If enrolled overseas Chinese students are found to have any of the following cases, the tuition and miscellaneous fees exemption shall be stopped and recovered.

(I) For overseas Chinese students who have been exempted from tuition and miscellaneous fees but have a temporary absence from school, transfer to another school, or drop out of school within 45 days (inclusive) from the semester's start date, the exemption of their tuition and miscellaneous fees shall be stopped, and the amount of the tuition and miscellaneous fees already paid shall be fully recovered.

(II) For overseas Chinese students exempted from tuition and miscellaneous fees but violate items (II) or (III) of the third point herein during the school attendance period, the exemption of their tuition and miscellaneous fees shall be stopped, and the amount of the tuition and miscellaneous fees already paid shall be completely recovered.

(III) For overseas Chinese students exempted from tuition and miscellaneous fees, the validity for benefitting from the exemption of tuition and miscellaneous fees shall be subject to the statutory length of study for the educational system of this school (excluding extended study). Those who have special circumstances to apply for the exemption of tuition and miscellaneous fees for an extended length of study shall report said circumstance to be approved.

(IV) Overseas Chinese students applying for exemption of tuition and miscellaneous fees shall not be approved if they fail to pass to the next grade, take courses in another department, or repeat courses (supplemented study) to earn credits (delayed graduation) again.

VII. Overseas Chinese students who have a temporary absence from school may file an application for the exemption of tuition and miscellaneous fees once they return to school.

VIII. The exempted amount shall be 1/3 of the total tuition and miscellaneous fees.

IX. The funds required to pay the exempted amount shall come from this school's annual 「Scholarship and Grants for Students' School Attendance」.

X. These important points shall be first approved by the Administrative Conference and then by the school's President prior to being implemented; the same shall apply to any revisions.
